

Sedona's Top Activities

1. Jeep Adventure Tours

Sedona's famous red-rock landscape offers adventure at every turn. Experience it for Each excursion offers an unforgettable backcountry tour with insider info from the area's most knowledgeable and experienced local guides.

Tours Range from 1.5 to 4 hours taking you to various locations in Sedona. For anyone seeking the adventure the Broken Arrow and Soldier's Pass trails are for you! Featuring some of the most iconic sites in Sedona coupled with rough and rugged adventure make them the most popular trails in town. Don't worry though, if you prefer a tour that allows you to sit back and take in the sites we have those too!

2. Day trip to the Grand Canyon

The Grand Canyon, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World is just a two hour drive from Sedona. Many people prefer to take a helicopter ride, guided shuttle tour or even a fun jeep tour to the Grand Canyon from Sedona, but you can also just drive yourself. It's an easy day trip to one of the most awe inspiring sites on this planet that you shouldn't miss it if you haven't been there already.

By Ground: Tours will pick up from Club Wyndham Sedona and drive you through Oak Creek Canyon and on to the Cameron Trading post. A short stop will be made for you to explore the historic post and then only a short drive to the Rim of the Canyon. A few hours will be spent exploring the canyon with your guide with time for lunch along the rim. **Average length: 10 hours | Average Cost \$150 to \$300 per person**

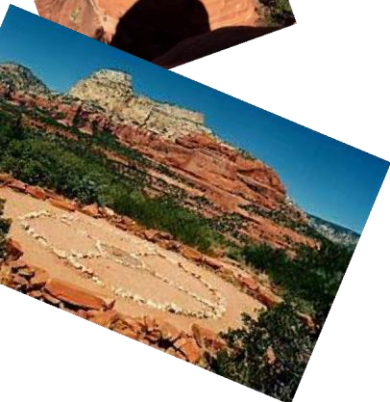
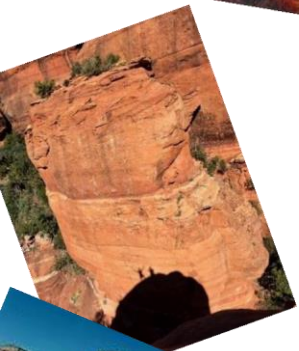
By Air: Local plane and helicopter companies offer a variety of options for flying to the Grand Canyon partnered with a ground experience. Options include jeep tours at the south rim, a simple overflight of the canyon, or the all-day west rim adventure. This adventure includes an airplane ride from Sedona to the West rim of the canyon followed by a helicopter ride to the bottom of the canyon. From there you board on to a gentle float on the Colorado river and a flight back to the top of the canyon. The remainder of the day is spent exploring the 3 iconic lookouts including the famous glass Skywalk and lunch at Guano point lookout. **Average length: 2 – 7 hours | Average Cost : \$200 to \$650 per person**

3. Guided Hiking Expedition We work with Sedona's most experienced wilderness guides in Red Rock Country. The local staff will ensure you explore Sedona as it's seldom seen by others. You will learn about ethnobotany, geology, Native American history, and wilderness survival skills. Each of the private hiking experiences comes complete and from the resort. **Average length : 2-4 hours | Average Cost: \$90 - \$165** with osprey backpacks for your use, organic snacks, water, and transportation to

4. Vortex Energy Tours and Healing Outings

More than just a tour, the vortex outings offer uniquely inspiring and transformative experience. Sedona is renowned for her awe inspiring beauty and majestically powerful vortexes. Our amazing tour guides assist you in accessing these energies. The guides use various spiritual techniques to support you while you gain clarity, insights, forgiveness, and inspiration. Dependent on the length of the outing you choose you will visit 1 to 3 of the vortexes.

Average length : 2 – 4 hours | Average Cost : \$70 to \$150





5. Helicopter Tour

Explore Sedona's iconic rock formations and 700-year-old Indian cliff dwellings on a one of Sedona's premier helicopter rides. Enjoy aerial views of the cliffs and ridges that define the Sonoran Desert landscaping. Soar above Cathedral Rock and Bell Rock, then steer past the imposing Three Nuns; take in Snoopy Rock and Steamboat Rock, and watch for the javelinas, elk and deer that thrive in the wild desert terrain. As you bank back towards Sedona, get a glimpse of Secret Canyon and see the cliff-side dwellings of the Sinaguan people, built high into an inaccessible cliff.

While the helicopter tours typically only last 15 to 45 minute they offer a unique and convenient way to take in all the sights while still having plenty of time in the day to explore.

Average length : 15 – 60 min | Average Cost : \$125 - \$365 per person

6. ATV/RZR/Jeep self guided Rentals

Free yourself from the standard scheduled tours and take your exploring into your own hands. By renting one of the ATV's of Jeeps in town you have the ability to explore so much more. Rentals are available in half, full and multi day rentals giving you more than enough time to see all the beautiful red rocks. Upon picking up your vehicle you will receive maps, advice and cooler to ensure you are set for success. **Average length : 4 hours | Average Cost : \$325 (seats 4)**

7. Wine Tours

With all 60 vineyards across the state, and over 20 vineyard and tasting room locations in and around Sedona encompassing the Verde Valley, we can create the perfect tour for everyone. Whether you are new to the world of wine or an experienced wine connoisseur; our experienced guides will put together the perfect tour to suit your interests. **Average length : 4 hours | Average Cost : \$200 - \$300 (fluctuates dependent on size of party)**

8. Hot Air Balloon

It all starts with an early morning drive to the launch site just out of town. The fun begins with the exciting inflation of the balloon and before you know it you are soaring with the eagles! Watch the sunrise during your ascent before gliding over the gorgeous red rock country. After a peaceful landing the team will have a champagne picnic awaiting you. **Average length : 4 hours in total (1.5 to 2 hours in the air) | Average Cost : \$225 per person**

9. Horseback Riding

Your adventure begins 30 minutes outside of Sedona at Dead Horse Ranch State Park in Cottonwood Arizona. On your ride, you can experience beauty and wildlife that is signature Arizona. The Verde River makes this a lush oasis in the desert where a wide variety of animals and plants reside that are unique to Sedona and the Verde Valley. Much of the land you ride through has been set aside as a National Treasure, so it should come as no surprise that some of the most beautiful horseback riding in Arizona can be found here as well. Couple your experience with lunch on the land and you have an experience you'll remember for a lifetime. **Average Length : 2 hours | Average Cost \$90**
